Proposals for sessions lasting less than 3 hours will not be considered. Presenters can submit a proposal for a 6-hour session (two 3-hour sessions). Please be very clear if individuals must register for/attend BOTH sessions.

Proposal Submission Deadline – April 1, 2020

We are looking for content in the following areas, but will consider other topic areas as well:

- Orthopaedic/Sports Physical Therapy
- Acute Care Physical Therapy
- Neurologic Physical Therapy
- Geriatric Physical Therapy
- Pediatric Physical Therapy
- Leadership/Management
- PTA Focused

Proposal Submission Information:

1. Proposal submissions for educational sessions must contain the following:

- A. Title
- B. Course Description
- C. Course Objectives
- D. Speaker Information
 - Name
 - Credentials
 - Institution
 - City/State
- E. Brief Biography for Each Speaker
- F. Target Audience (PTs, PTAs, Student PTs, Student PTAs, Other Disciplines)
- G. MAXIMUM Number of Participants (lab-based sessions)

2. Important things to consider when submitting your proposal:

- A. Sessions with lab components are popular. If your session will include a lab, please indicate that in the description.
- B. Please list any materials/equipment that the participant will be expected to bring.
- C. Please list any materials/equipment or demonstration space that you need to be available onsite.
- D. Speaker information will appear exactly as submitted in all publications both in print and online. Please ensure the accuracy of this information before finalizing your submission.
- E. The ALAPTA Education Committee will review all proposals. Selection of proposals will be based on the foundation in evidence, clarity of proposal, probable interest to participants, fiscal feasibility, and space/time constraints.
- F. Proposals should reflect cultural and/or ethical components related to clinical practice and research as related to session content.
- G. Proposals should be devoid of any promotional content.
- H. Honorarium is offered at \$100/hour (\$300 per session) for one person or shared amongst multiple speakers. One night's accommodation at the conference hotel may be offered to out of town speakers along with mileage reimbursement at the IRS approved rate. If there is more than one speaker, they will be expected to share the hotel room and carpool.
