	Has worked with the Governmental Affairs Committee and/or APTA Alabama lobbyist.
	Has participated in political activities that have directly influenced state and/or national legislation.
Barbara Bra	dford Leadership Award
	recognize an APTA Alabama Member who has made significant contributions resulting in Chapter growth as well as individuals who strated outstanding leadership in their service to APTA Alabama.
Eligibility:	
	APTA Alabama Member
	Has been involved as a Chapter leader for a minimum of two (2) years.
Physical The	erapy Advocate Award
Purpose: To	recognize an individual outside of the profession whose activities promote and elevate the practice of physical therapy.
Eligibility:	
	Not a licensed PT or PTA
	Has participated in activities that facilitate the delivery of effective physical therapy services and/or enhance public awareness of physical therapy.
Innovations	in Physical Therapy Award
Purpose: To	honor a physical therapy professional or clinic demonstrating futuristic thinking through innovative programming.
Eligibility:	
	APTA Alabama Member. Clinics nominated must employ at least one APTA Alabama Member.
	Demonstrate that activities have represented creative and effective solutions to problems interfering with the optimal delivery of physical therapy services.
